A musician going on a toilet break must take the shortest route between the other musicians to exit, do this promptly and not stop whilst traversing the room.</p> <p>Musicians will be expected to bring appropriate PPE if they require it but it is not mandatory. At the start of each day and between breaks copyists will lay out the sheet music on tables in the studio area for the musicians to collect. The sheet music once done with will be collected by the copyist once the musicians have vacated the studio.
